SUBJECT: 2011 Rapid Sequence Intubation (RSI) Training Schedule

APPLICABILITY: Career Paramedics

The Bureau of Education and Training, EMS Training Branch is announcing the 2011 training schedule for Rapid Sequence Intervention (RSI).

1 QUARTERLY REFRESHER TRAINING

1.1 Quarterly Refresher Training for RSI will be offered at the Public Safety Training Center as follows:

- 1.1.1 Wednesday, June 15, 2011 (B Shift) from 1230 hrs to 1600 hrs
- 1.1.2 Thursday, September 15, 2011 (A Shift) from 0800 hrs to 1200 hrs
- 1.1.3 Thursday, December 15, 2011 (B Shift) from 1230 hrs to 1600 hrs

1.2 Providers may register for a training session by submitting a course request form.

1.3 Cadaver lab and operating room rotations will be available throughout the year. Providers in the RSI educational process should check the EMS Training Branch calendar on the intranet for available dates and times.

2 INITIAL TRAINING

2.1 Two offerings of the initial presentation for Rapid Sequence Intubation (RSI) will be held at the Public Safety Training Center:

- 2.1.1 Wednesday, June 15, 2011 (B Shift) from 0800 hrs to 1200 hrs
- 2.1.2 Thursday, December 15, 2011 (B Shift) from 0800 hrs to 1200 hrs

2.2 Interested providers should refer to the certification process and application procedures established in General Order 322.06, Rapid Sequence Intubation, also summarized below:

- 2.2.1 Submit a complete application form [Attachment A] with required signatures through the Chain of Command to the Medical Director.
- 2.2.2 Contact Lt/P Rick Leonard at leonard@howardcountymd.gov to schedule a Fundamentals Test.

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- 2.2.3 Providers who successfully complete the Fundamentals Test will be contacted to schedule an entrance interview with the Medical Director.
- 2.2.4 Providers that receive approval from the Medical Director following the interview will be registered for the initial presentation.
- 2.3 Participants in either initial presentation may also participate in the Quarterly Refresher Training on the same date.
